## **MEMBERSHIP & SHOOTING FEES 1<sup>st</sup> Oct 2022 to 30<sup>th</sup> Sept 2023**

The fees involved for membership of the club are made up as follows:

- **Annual Membership Fee: Archery GB**
- **Monthly Shooting Fee: Parkfield Archers**
- **Annual Affiliation Fees: County & Regional : Cambridge Archery Association & Southern Counties Archery Society**

There is a brief description of each below and tables of fees are on the following page.

### **i. Annual Membership Fee: Archery GB**

It is mandatory for anyone wishing to shoot at Parkfield Archers Club, to have fully paid up membership of Archery GB. Membership provides the necessary insurance and governance required to allow the club to operate and for its members to shoot. The annual Archery GB membership runs from 1<sup>st</sup> October and is a single, annual 'lump sum' advance payment, There is a pro-rata rate for anyone joining between 1<sup>st</sup> April and 30<sup>th</sup> Sept, which is equal to half of the Annual Fee. The Fees are payable by cash or cheque payable to 'Archery GB' and given to the club Treasurer and are processed through to Archery GB on your behalf. You will receive an official membership card and regular magazine direct from Archery GB.

### **ii. Monthly Shooting Fee: Parkfield Archers**

This provides regular funding to cover club shooting venue hire, provision and maintenance of equipment and general running costs of the Club. These rates are reviewed annually. To ease the administration effort, we require monthly payment by standing order from your bank, Payment by cheque or cash monthly in advance may be considered as an exception.

### **iii. Annual Affiliation Fee: Cambridge Archery & Southern Counties Archery Society**

It is mandatory for every member at Parkfield Archers Club, to have fully paid up membership of the **CAA** and **SCAS**. The **Cambridgeshire Archery Association** is an umbrella organization which represents archery clubs in Cambridgeshire. The **Southern Counties Archery Association** promotes or supports archery such as organising and running tournaments, providing help and grants to clubs, training development and support for judges and coaches and supporting archers in the region. The annual membership runs from 1st October. When funds allow, these fees will be paid by the Club. This benefit is reviewed each year.

The relevant Archery GB membership fee is applicable from the date the new member joins the club.

\*New members joining through a club can join at the pro-rata rate if they join on or after April 1<sup>st</sup>, on or after July 1<sup>st</sup>, or, on or after 1<sup>st</sup> September, and have either never been an Archery GB member before, or have had a break in their membership of Archery GB for 18 months or more.

**ii. Monthly Club Membership Fee: Parkfield Archers** (pay by standing order to Parkfield Archers)

<b>Per Household</b>	<b>Monthly £</b>
1st Adult (18 or over)	<b>12.00</b>
Additional Adults (each)	<b>9.00</b>
1st Junior (under 18)	<b>6.00</b>
Additional Juniors (each)	<b>4.50</b>

Example: A single household of 2 adult members and 2 junior members, all shooting would be £31.50 (£12 + £9 + £6 + £4.50)
