Beginners Courses are usually run over four consecutive Sunday morning 10am-12noon

The cost includes the 8 hours tuition by ArcheryGB qualified coaches assisted by trainee coaches or experienced Senior Club members, all equipment required for the duration of the course and a certificate. At time of writing the cost is £60 per adult and £30 per child Under 18. Successful completion will allow you to apply to join any ArcheryGB club (most clubs in the UK). There is no commitment to join any club if you prefer not to.

Parkfield Archers Club Membership & Archery Equipment

The club requires all applicants to become members of our governing body, ArcheryGB. At time of writing, their **annual** fee is less than £50 for over 25's and less than £20 for Under 25's or Disabled. (all *reduced for first payment if joining at certain points through the year - their year begins 1st October*). This is payable via the club. In addition to this, the monthly Club membership fee payable by bank standing order is currently £12 adults, £6 child under 18. There are currently some concessionary rates for families/households. There are also small annual fees of less than £10 payable to our County and Regional governing bodies – but at time of writing, these are paid by the club when existing funds allow. The fees cover the cost of venue hire, bosses, targets, equipment storage and equipment & liability insurance.

We are often asked how much the equipment that an archer needs costs and where to buy it from. **Suitable equipment will be specific to the archer** and depends on their age, stature, fitness & strength and the style of archery they wish to follow. We advise that you wait until after successful completion of a beginners course before purchasing any bow or arrows. Beginner's recurve style bows, arrows and safety kit, like those used on the beginners course, can be bought as a kit at a reputable archery shop for around £150 - £200 and are quite adequate for new and improving archers. An archer's needs will be unique to them. We always advise a chat with a coach who can advise on what to look at, what not to buy and advise on reputable suppliers. This will save you expensive mistakes and wasted time. Where club stocks allow, a bow and arrows will be made available to new members who have just completed a beginner course, for their first couple of weeks, after which it will be expected that they acquire their own suitable equipment.
