Awards	 Medals will be awarded for the top three Senior and top three Junior scores (after handicap value adjustment) in each bow category. Archers will have to shoot their age appropriate round or above (please see chart above) and have submitted their validated handicap value at registration or before. For each bow category and age group a single Gold medal will be awarded to the archer who achieves the greatest score over-all (before handicap adjustment). In all cases , Archers must have shot their age appropriate round or greater, to qualify for an award.
