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<b>Target &amp; Scoring</b>	Archery GB Imperial Outdoor Rounds 5 Zone Scoring – 122cm Face
<b>Bow Categories</b>	Barebow (B), Compound (C), Longbow (L), Recurve (R)
<b>Awards</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Medals will be awarded for the top three Senior and top three Junior scores (after handicap value adjustment ) in each bow category. Archers will have to shoot their age appropriate round or above (please see chart above) and have submitted their validated handicap value at registration or before.</li> <li>For each bow category and age group a single Gold medal will be awarded to the archer who achieves the greatest score over-all (before handicap adjustment). In all cases , Archers must have shot their age appropriate round or greater, to qualify for an award.</li> </ul>
<b>Catering</b>	Tea & coffee and water will be available all day. Some modest amounts of cake also likely.
<b>Suitable Clothing</b>	Dress Rule 307 of AGB Rules of Shooting will apply. (No blue Denim, no open-toed footwear, no bare midriff , no fashionable rips in jeans, gents tops must have sleeves etc)
<b>Liability</b>	Parkfield Archers, Parkfield Sports Club or their agents and servants cannot accept any responsibility for any loss damage or injury however caused. Entry to the tournament will be taken as acceptance of these conditions
<b>Data Handling</b>	Parkfield Archers require your permission to collect, use and store personal and other data about you in order to carry out the normal competition administration. By entering this event, archers are consenting to this (via the Guardians/parents for Junior Archers). Data may be shared by the tournament organisers, with the judges, fellow competitors, Southern Counties Archery Society (Regional body) and Archery GB. No archer's personal contact information or dates of birth relating to Junior archers will be published or shared and will only be used by the organisers to ensure compliance with competition rules.
<b>Photography</b>	In line with Archery GB's Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event must provide personal identification and register with the tournament organisers at the Registration desk prior to commencement of the tournament. Where other people's children can be facially identified in pictures or videos, images must not be shared or published on social media or in print.
