Bow Categories	Barebow (B), Compound (C), Longbow (L), Recurve (R)
Arrows	The sportsground is a shared facility. All arrows must be identifiable & all lost arrows MUST be found
Awards	Medals will be awarded for the top three Senior and top three Junior scores in each age & bow category. Archers will have to shoot their age appropriate distances or above to be eligible for a medal. <i>(Novices/beginners excepted)</i>
Catering	Tea & coffee and water will be available all day. Some modest amounts of cake also likely.
Clothing	Dress Rule 307 of AGB Rules of Shooting will apply. (No blue Denim, no open-toed No heeled or wheeled footwear, no bare midriff, no fashionable rips in jeans, gents tops must have sleeves etc)
Liability	Parkfield Archers, Parkfield Sports Club or their agents and servants cannot accept any responsibility for any loss damage or injury however caused. Entry to the tournament will be taken as acceptance of these conditions
Data Handling	Parkfield Archers require your permission to collect, use and store personal and other data about you in order to carry out the normal competition administration. By entering this event, archers are consenting to this (via the Guardians/parents for Junior Archers). Data may be shared by the tournament organisers, with the judges, fellow competitors, Southern Counties Archery Society (Regional body) and Archery GB. No archer's personal contact information or dates of birth relating to Junior archers will be published or shared and will only be used by the organisers to ensure compliance with competition rules.
Photography	In line with Archery GB's Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event must provide personal identification and register with the tournament organisers at the Registration desk prior to commencement of the tournament. Where other people's children can be facially identified in pictures or videos, images must not be shared or published on social media or in print.

Events in 2024, Age Appropriate Group Calculation

- **50+** An archer may compete in the 50+ division when the competition takes place in the year of their 50th Birthday and thereafter.
- **U21** An archer who was under 21 yrs on the 31/12/23 and will not become 21 during 2024. If an archer will become 21 during 2024, they must shoot in the Men or Women categories.
- **U18** An archer who was under 18 yrs on the 31/12/23 and will not become 18 during 2024. If an archer will become 18 during 2024, they must shoot in the U21 category (or older category.)
- **U16** An archer who was under 16 yrs on the 31/12/23 and will not become 16 during 2024. If an archer will become 16 during 2024, they must shoot in the U18 category (or older category.)
- **U15** An archer who was under 15 yrs on the 31/12/23 and will not become 15 during 2024. If an archer will become 15 during 2024, they must shoot in the U16 category (or older category.)
- **U14** An archer who was under 14 yrs on the 31/12/23 and will not become 14 during 2024. If an archer will become 14 during 2024, they must shoot in the U15 category (or older category.)
- **U12** An archer who was under 12 yrs on the 31/12/23 and will not become 12 during 2024. If an archer will become 12 during 2024, they must shoot in the U14 category (or older category.)
